Dear NPC Latvia,

I hope this email finds you well. As mentioned in my email from 08 July 2024, World Para Ice Hockey will offer a training camp from emerging nations in Riga Latvia.

We would therefore like to invite 6 participants from Latvia to attend the camp on 17-21 October 2024.

WPIH will support six participants of four NPCs by covering expenses such as transportation, accommodation, meals, on-ice training and off-ice training.

To be eligible to participate in the camp, the NPCs must meet the following criteria:

- Have five athletes with an eligible impairment as per WPIH regulations (a Medical Diagnostic Form will be required)
- Have two of the five athletes be women
- Have one coaching staff as part of their six-participant allocation
- Confirm that their five athletes have their own equipment (sledges, sticks, and protective equipment)

Could you kindly confirm if your NPC has athletes that would be interested in attending the camp?
